
FIXED INCOME SECURITIES - BASICS

- High Risk as compared to Fixed Income
- No Fixed Source of Income
- Higher Price Volatility
 as compared to Fixed
 Income Securities
- Commonly referred to as stock markets & Private Equity Industry



Fixed Income

- Less Risky due to regular payments & recurring cash inflows
- Fixed and Regular
 Source of Income by way of Interest
- Lower Price Volatility as compared to other Asset Class
- Commonly referred to as the *debt market*
